

The Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT) was signed on July 1, 1968. According to the U.N., "More countries have ratified the NPT than any other arms limitation and disarmament agreement, a testament to the treaty's significance." Only five countries are not party to the treaty: Noth Korea, South Sudan, India, Pakistan, and Israel.

Kumi Week #26: Nuclear Israel

Week 26 of Kumi Now is now available on the website. The Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT) was signed on July 1, 1968. According to the U.N., "More countries have ratified the NPT than any other arms limitation and disarmament agreement, a testament to the treaty's significance." Only five countries are not party to the treaty: Noth Korea, South Sudan, India, Pakistan, and Israel. As we mark the anniversary of this important treaty, the Kumi Now community looks at the story of how the world came to know that Israel possessed nuclear weapons and examines what this means for Palestine and the region, so that together we can *rise up*.

Just the facts...

Israel began nuclear research in 1948 with French assistance.

Its first nuclear weapon was completed in late 1966/early 1967, making it the 6th nuclear power.

Israel is believed to possess 90 plutonium-based nuclear warheads and have enough plutonium for 100-200 weapons.

Israel is not party to any of the major treaties governing nonproliferation, including the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT), the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR), and the Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention (BTWC).

Israel's nuclear arms secrets were disclosed by nuclear reactor technician Mordechai Vanunu in 1986.

Mossad agents abducted him from Europe and returned him to Israel to stand trial for espionage and treason.

He was sentenced to 18 years imprisonment, 12 of which were served in solitary confinement.

Since his release in 2004, Vanunu has been barred from speaking to foreigners and leaving the country, and has his internet and phone usage monitored.

Vanunu has been repeatedly arrested for offenses such as talking to foreigners in bookshops, meeting his girlfriend, traveling to the West Bank, and giving interviews.

Understanding Nuclear Israel: Just the Facts...

 Israel began to research nuclear weapons soon after it declared independence in 1948 and secretly built the Shimon Peres Negev Nuclear Research Center with French assistance.

- Its first nuclear weapon was completed in late 1966 or early 1967, making it the sixth nuclear power.
- Israel is believed to be able to launch nuclear warheads by aircraft, as submarinelaunched cruise missiles, and via intermediate to intercontinental range ballistic missiles.
- Israel is believed to possess 90 plutonium-based nuclear warheads and have enough plutonium for 100-200 weapons.
- It is believed that Israel conducted a nuclear weapons test with South Africa in 1979 known as the Vela incident.
- There are reports that 300 kilograms of weapons-grade uranium was diverted from the U.S. to Israel in the late 1960s.
- Israel is not a party to any of the major treaties governing WMD nonproliferation, including the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT), the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR), and the Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention (BTWC).
- It has signed, but not ratified, the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty (CTBT) and the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC).
- Israel's nuclear arms secrets were disclosed to the London Sunday Times by nuclear reactor technician Mordechai Vanunu in 1986.
- Mossad agents abducted him from Europe and returned him to Israel to stand trial for espionage and treason.
- He was sentenced to 18 years imprisonment, 12 of which were served in solitary confinement.
- Since his release in 2004, Vanunu has been barred from speaking to foreigners and leaving the country, and has his internet and phone usage monitored.
- Vanunu has been repeatedly arrested for offenses such as talking to foreigners in bookshops, meeting his girlfriend, traveling to the West Bank, and giving interviews.

Israel's oppression of Palestinians and flouting of United Nations resolutions is ongoing and unwavering. Dozens of international corporations profit off this oppression by contracting with the Israeli government and participating in the construction of illegal settlements. As we mark the beginnings of the BDS Movement on July 9, 2005, here's what you need to know about morally responsible investment and what you can do so that together we can rise up.

For our Kumi Action we write to our church, company, school, place of worship, or any community we belong to and find out where/how they invest their money.



July 20: Week 29 - The Israeli Apartheid Wall

Read the full entry online.

Resolution ES-10/15 doesn't, in name, sound like much. But it was a resolution passed on July 20, 2004 that acknowledged the illegality of Israel's separation barrier under international law. Years later, Palestinian communities in the occupied territory are still being torn apart due to the construction of the separation barrier, otherwise known as the Apartheid Wall. As the wall gets built, Israel is effectively annexing more and more Palestinian land to itself.

For our Kumi Action we will send empty boxes to the Knesset, showing them how easy it is to open a gate or barrier.



Read the full entry online.

On July 31, 2003 Israel passed the Nationality and Entry into Israel Law, making the lives of thousands of Palestinian individuals and families even more precarious and complex.

For our Kumi Action we will send the Prime Minister and his cabinet paper dolls to move around and play with.
