#### A call for global Action and solidarity on Nakba Day May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Israel's Continuing Apartheid, Ethnic Cleansing, forcible displacement and Now Genocide

#### Back ground

In November 2023, Israel Security Cabinet Member Avi Dichter declared, "We are now rolling out the Gaza Nakba. Gaza Nakba 2023. That's how it'll end." Numbers from the war-tom Gaza Strip are proving Israel's intent.

According to the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian <u>undate report</u> on <u>April 15th 2024</u>, 33,797 Gazans have been killed by Israeli air strikes, tanks, snipers and soldiers on the ground. The number of dead still under the rubble is unknown. 76,465people have been injured. 1.7 million Palestinians (80% of the population) have been facility displaced. White ways 14,000 children have been facility and thousands more

May 15th marks 76 years of the Nakba. Help mark the date and make sure the world doesn't forget by participating in the actions outlined by Kairos Palestine in this document.




#### U.S.

While many eyes are on Iran and the wider region, the devastations in Gaza continue, along with U.S. funding of Israel's military operations.

On Saturday the U.S. House of Representatives passed a bill which, if passed by the Senate, will allocate some \$17 billion in military supplies to Israel, along with \$9 billion pledged for humanitarian support. The bill also continues the prohibition of U.S. funds to UNRWA.
