A call for global Action and solidarity on Nakba Day May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Israel's Continuing Apartheid, Ethnic Cleansing, forcible displacement and Now Genocide

Back ground:

In November 2023, Israel Security Cabinet Member Avi Dichter declared, "We are now rolling out the Gaza Nakba. Gaza Nakba 2023. That's how it'll end." Numbers from the war-torn Gaza Strip are proving Israel's intent.

According to the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian <u>update report</u> on <u>April 15th 2024</u>, 33,797 Gazans have been killed by Israeli air strikes, tanks, snipers and soldiers on the ground. The number of dead still under the rubble is unknown. 76 465people have been injured. 1.7 million Palestinians (80% of the population) have been forsible vice to 400 publicates being been the provided more
